

Minutes of Bradwell Monitoring Committee - WMTC - Draft - 16th May 2017

- Remind CBC Cllr Paul Smith he promised to attend (BT via Varrie? to CBC)

Richard Haward updated us the MCZ potency and action by the Tollesbury and Mersea Oyster Co. including the forthcoming renewal of the Several Order. Ian Clarke drew our attention to potential of competitive bidding by the Chinese for the Several Order. Cllr. Weaver updated us on FAB, dormant but ready. Similarly Bea Chandler updated us that the Blackwater Guardian status was similar. Barry Turner updated us on the recent BANNING meeting in Maldon.
