

## Further Notes to Minutes - Mr Ian Clarke

19/012 It was acknowledged that even if the intake and outfall was outside the MCZ it would still impact on it due to tidal effects and the area inside and outside the MCZ to the east was used by local fishing boats so giving WMTC a legitimate interest in its siting.

19/013 The relevance of the new NDA regime for “continuous decommissioning” without a phase of “care and maintenance” was discussed. It was decided (?) to seek confirmation at the LCLC that Bradwell would remain in the earlier care and maintenance regime

19/014 A further meeting with the EA is anticipated in February 2020 however they or BRB could be invited to attend WMTC . It was not considered that a public meeting should be arranged until and unless Bradwell was included in the further site selection process.

19/016 RM had asked that the economic benefits (if any ) should be considered together with dis-benefits . It was agreed (?) that that these should be considered but limited in scope to that of the local economy ie to then be within the remit of the Council.
